



# FALL LEAF WREATH



This is a wonderful craft project for any age. It's quick to put together and brings some of the outside in.

## Materials:

- Fresh Fall leaves in various colors
- Paper plate
- White school glue
- Scissors
- Pretty ribbon



## Instructions:

- STEP 1** Collect about twenty colorful leaves from outside. Try to get nice fresh ones that have just fallen as they will be easier to glue on.
- STEPS 2-3** Cut the middle out from a paper plate. Fold the plate in half to get the cut started in the middle, then cut along the rim to make about a 2 inch paper plate border.
- STEP 4** Glue each leaf to the paper plate. Slightly overlap each leaf. Arrange each leaf to point in the same direction, with the stems pointing inward.
- STEP 5** Clip off the stems from each leaf using scissors.
- STEP 6** Tie a pretty Fall ribbon in a bow, then glue the bow on to the wreath.
